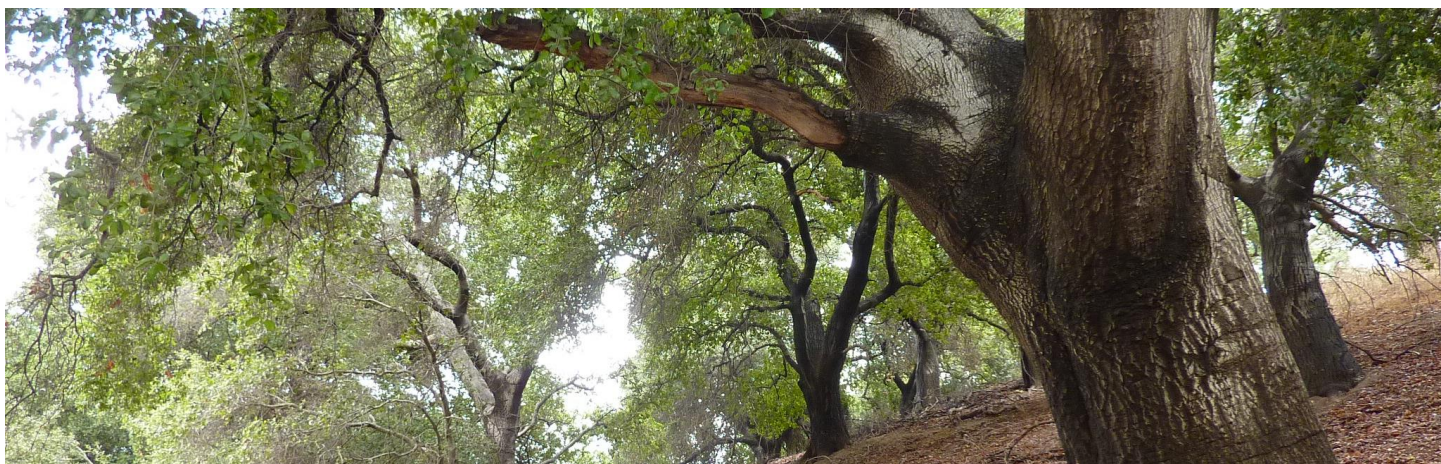




Volunteer for Oaks! Acorn Planting Event

Join **Rivers & Lands Conservancy** as we plant germinated acorns in the Cienega Canyon Preserve! Over the last decade, oaks in the Preserve have died from drought, pests, and pathogens. The loss of oaks means the loss of food and shelter for wildlife that rely on oaks for their survival. In order to help restore lost oaks, we are planting acorns with weed mats and protective screens to give them their best chance at survival. *All ages are welcome to attend!*

Use either of the addresses below to access Cienega Canyon Preserve, PLEASE DO NOT bother residents. Reference map added as an attachment image:

34120 Ogrady Ct,
Beaumont, CA 92223

1. Park on Ogrady Court.
2. Access preserve through pedestrian entrance off to the right of the end of the Ogrady Court cul-de-sac
3. Walk to end of dirt road and turn left
4. You made it!

34020 Crenshaw St
Beaumont, CA 92223

1. Park on Crenshaw Street.
2. Access preserve at the northwest end of Crenshaw Street Cul-de-sac (no fencing)
3. Walk to the end of dirt trail and turn right
4. You made it!
