WHERE: San Andreas Avenue trailhead. (Park at Ryan Bonaminio Park and walk up San Andreas Avenue about 0.2 miles to the trailhead. We will meet at the "Frank A. Miller Mt. Rubidoux Memorial Park" sign.)

WHO: Open to everyone aged 7 and up. Participants must be able to walk up to Mt. Rubidoux Peak (~ 2 miles roundtrip), walk over steep, uneven terrain, pick up trash, and cover graffiti with paint.

WHAT TO BRING: Bring your own reusable water bottle! Snacks, work gloves, and garbage bags will be provided.
