Use either of the addresses below for parking adjacent to the Cienega Canyon Preserve, PLEASE DO NOT disturb residents. If you have any trouble finding the parking areas, please call Nicole's cell at 909-247-8890.

34120 Ogrady Ct,
Beaumont, CA 92223

1. Park on Ogrady Court.
2. Access preserve through pedestrian entrance in fence off to the right of the end of the Ogrady Court cul-de-sac
3. Walk to end of dirt road and turn left
4. You made it!

34020 Crenshaw St
Beaumont, CA 92223

1. Park on Crenshaw Street.
2. Access preserve at the northwest end of Crenshaw Street cul-de-sac (no fencing)
3. Walk to the end of dirt trail and turn right
4. You made it!
