

Oak Seedling Watering & Mulching Restoration Event

Join **Rivers & Lands Conservancy** as we care for our oak seedlings in the Cienega Canyon Preserve! Over the last decade, oaks in the preserve have died from drought, pests, and pathogens. The loss of oaks means the loss of food and shelter for wildlife that rely on oaks for their survival. In order to help restore lost oaks, we planted acorns in January. We need your help watering, mulching, and weeding them to give them their best chance at survival. *All ages are welcome to attend!*
