This unique habitat is home to many unique flora and fauna, including the endangered Delhi Sands Flower-loving Fly which can be found nowhere else in the world. This fly was the first fly added to the federal endangered species list. Rivers & Lands Conservancy works to protect this endangered species as well as the dunes it lives in.
