Join Rivers & Lands Conservancy as we restore Cienega Canyon's Creeks & Hills! Over the last decade, the Preserve's riparian habitat have been impacted by pollution, drought, pests, and pathogens. The loss of this type of ecosystem means the loss of food and shelter for wildlife that rely on a riparian habitat for their survival. To help restore the Preserve, we will be planting native vegetation, weeding and mulching to foster a healthy canyon for all.





Minors must be accompanied by an adult and under their supervision for the entire event. Wear long pants, long sleeves, and comfortable closed-toed shoes you don't mind getting dirty. Bring sun protection and a refillable water bottle – tools, extra water, and snacks will be provided.

Directions to the Cienega Canyon Preserve:

Use either of the addresses below for parking near Cienega Canyon Preserve, PLEASE DO NOT disturb residents. If you have any trouble finding the parking areas, please call Nicole's cell at 909-247-8890.

34120 Ogrady Ct, Beaumont, CA 92223

- 1. Park on Ogrady Court.
- 2. Access preserve through pedestrian entrance in fence off to the right of the end of the Ogrady Court cul-de-sac
- 3. Walk to end of dirt road and turn left
- 4. You made it!

34020 Crenshaw St Beaumont, CA 92223

- 1. Park on Crenshaw Street.
- 2. Access preserve at the northwest end of Crenshaw Street cul-de-sac (no fencing)
- 3. Walk to the end of dirt trail and turn right
- 4. You made it!
